## Message from the Chief Buddy Robshaw

### SPECIAL ENFORCEMENT SLATED FOR CHEVERLY

While serving as a member of the county police, I spent fifteen (15) years as a Narcotics Division investigator, supervisor, and ultimately the division commander. Of the many things that I have learned over the years about illegal drugs, the one fact that still sticks with me is the omnipresent culture of violence that constantly swirls around and accompanies the use of illegal drugs. That is not to say that every person who uses drugs is a violent thug, it just means that the illegal distribution and use of these drugs frequently serves as the catalyst for so much crime.

Over a period of the last year, the Cheverly Police Department has noted a consistent rise in drug use throughout the town, with particular emphasis in and near the Landover Road corridor. Arrest rates within the police department have risen considerably because of drug arrests, and drug seizures this year will surely reach over \$200,000.00. In the last two weeks alone, three handguns were seized from persons suspected to be members of the drug culture and year-to-date currency seizures are substantial. At the same time, citizen robberies have risen at a rate that seems to be consistent with the presence of the drug culture as have property crimes that seem to be used by this culture as a funds generator.

As Chief of Police, I made a specific promise to the Mayor, Council, and citizens of this town that I would do everything possible to reduce crime, with particular attention toward reducing violence. As part of that promise, I have now ordered a zero tolerance policy regarding illegal drugs be put in place in the town for the next six months. This policy means that every person who is found in possession of illegal drugs (regardless of amount) will be arrested and prosecuted, that all vehicles and or monies used to distribute these drugs will be promptly seized for forfeiture, and that trespassing, loitering, and curfew violations will now be strictly enforced. The intention of this policy is not to trample on anyone's constitutional rights or to generate undue publicity, but to make it as difficult as possible for members of the drug culture to ply their trade in Cheverly.

In conjunction with this policy, I have also authorized the use of additional overtime monies to bolster enforcement and to increase the number and fre-

quency of enforcement activities. This overtime will include both uniform and plainclothes officers, additional alcohol-related traffic and pedestrian enforcement, as well as drug education and awareness programs. To make this effort a total success, I am requesting that parents take the time to talk with their children about illegal drugs and the dangers of drug use, and to also talk to them about choosing good friends. The drug culture in Cheverly, much like anywhere else, maintains itself upon a foundation of peer pressure.

#### Other Items.....

\* The **Chief's Advisory Board /Neighborhood Watch meeting**, while not well attended, produced some great ideas at the October meeting. It was particularly heartening to have some folks from the apartments attend, and the resident manager for Cheverly Terrace / Hanson Arms has promised to be at the next meeting. Some of the ideas generated from this meeting are included in this newsletter. The next meeting will be **Wednesday, November 30, 2005, at 7:00 PM.** Please note the time change. Refreshments will be served.

\* Please call my office as soon as possible (the next business day) if you had any problem getting through to police communications for a call for service or complaint. Cheverly Police Department officers share communications channels with the Prince George's County Police, and occasionally it may be difficult to get someone to answer the telephone promptly or to get a Cheverly car dispatched. If these problems occur, I need to know about them.

\* The Cheverly Police Department currently has vacancies in the department. If you know of anyone who may be interested in a law enforcement career, please call the department at **(301) 773-8362**. Preference is given to candidates who are currently certified by the Maryland Police and Correctional Training Commission (MPCTC).

\* Cheverly has a strict policy regarding door-to-door solicitation. If you encounter anyone involved in this activity, please do not hesitate to call the office during the day or police communications after 5:00 PM and on weekends.





# LEAF COLLECTION PROCEDURES



**Vacuum Leaves:** Every street in Cheverly is scheduled for at least 2 vacuuming sweeps.

- Rake leaves between the curb and sidewalk - not on the street or sidewalk.
- Keep leaves free of twigs, branches, metal, concrete and other debris that can jam or damage the equipment.
- Please do not park cars on the street on the assigned collection day.

**Bag Leaves:** Yard waste is collected on **MONDAYS**. Put bags at the curb on Sunday evening. Use **CLEAR PLASTIC BAGS** only (sold at Town Hall-\$5 for 50 bags). Yard waste includes leaves, grass, brush, twigs, etc. Do not put any dirt, rocks, or other trash/debris in these bags.
